1696		New coinage issued
1698		Whitehall palace burned down
1700	Birth of sister Suzanne	New Huguenot chapel opened off Charing X road
1702		Death William III. Accession of Queen Anne.
1703		Hurricane in London
1704	Parents apply to charity for money (3 times)	
1705	Birth of brother Daniel. Parents apply again for money	Her Majesty's Theatre built
1707		Epidemic of flies in London
1708	Death of Daniel	Attempt to ban the May Fair
1709	Parents apply to charity for money (twice). Mother dies soon after.

1717	Marries Jeanne Bonouvrier	Inoculation against smallpox introduced into England by Lady Mary Wortley-Montagu


